Served as a Senior JavaScript Engineer on Automatic's Product and Marketing Engineering teams in the Jetpack division, leading the delivery of high-impact web initiatives end-to-end. Owned technical discovery, project scoping, architecture decisions, and production deployments. Collaborated cross-functionally with design, marketing, and product to drive business outcomes, while mentoring engineers and maintaining code quality via unit testing and code reviews.

- Contributed significantly to large-scale open-source projects supporting millions of users, including [Automatic/Calypso](#) (WordPress.com) and [Automatic/Jetpack](#) (Jetpack plugin). Authored and merged hundreds of pull requests into production across these codebases.
- Delivered 60+ high-impact engineering projects, including initial exploration & research, scoping & planning, time estimation, technical implementation, testing, and deployment.
- Worked cross-collaboratively with the Design team to translate Figma designs into responsive, accessible, pixel-perfect UIs built with React and TypeScript.
- Architected, implemented, & optimized REST API endpoints, handling data transformations, error states, caching, and authentication, supporting scalable feature development and improving response times by 40%, ensuring maintainable, well-documented interfaces for frontend consumption.
- Built and refined extensible React components within Automatic's component library and design system, promoting visual consistency, accessibility, and developer efficiency across WordPress.com interfaces.
- I was part of the core team that built and launched Automatic's first AI product, "Jetpack AI". I implemented and shipped many of the React/TypeScript frontend UI flows for the AI client.

Integrated facial recognition AI models via C++/Web Assembly (WASM) to enable advanced face detection features across web platform media devices (i.e.- webcam). Collaborated with cross-functional teams to translate complex AI capabilities into intuitive, user-friendly interfaces. Structured front-end architecture to support scalability, performance, and maintainability of AR-driven web applications.

- Architected & implemented a flexible, maintainable JavaScript library for quickly loading and interfacing (via WASM) with our local facial recognition AI model and the browser's media device (webcam or front-facing phone camera), providing developer-friendly access to encapsulated, pre-built, extensible functionalities that we could re-use to quickly build and customize interactive, real-time webcam/canvas experiences.
